The Waterfront Pavilion Shopping Center features the first festival waterfront market place in Dubai, with two themed pavilions, "Trade Routes" and "Hub & Taste", and over 100 shops and kiosks, each bringing with them totally different yet memorable experiences for visitors to discover.

**Trade Routes:** Combining two pavilions in one, this marketplace is designed in the style of the traditional Dubai Souk. The mixture of historic and modern is captured in the architecture and the small shops selling carpets, traditional crafts and souvenirs.

**Hub & Taste:** This dining pavilion, overlooking Festive Marina, features a complete urban environment, with restaurants, casual dining and live entertainment.
